ROLE PURPOSE

Power BI developer required for an initial 3 months contract, rate £400 per day.

- Collate the backlog of BI requirements and assist with prioritization.
- Analyze data and produce insight from SQL or Excel data sources in response to internal requests.
- Carry out data quality audits and distribute data quality reports when required.
