ROLE PURPOSE

Instant are looking to expand their technical team and recruit an IT Project Manager to continue its successful growth trajectory. You will have a passion for successful solution delivery, with expertise in the application, online and digital space. Your core discipline and role will be in IT project management; however, this is a varied and hands on role where you will be required to get involved in many different aspects of project delivery such as product management, technology strategy, solution / supplier selection, business analysis, software testing and training.

Reporting into the CTO you will be part of a small but effective IT team that is well integrated with other key business functions to drive the overall business strategy.

KEY RESPONSIBILITIES

You will take ownership of several prioritized projects, project work streams and change initiatives for internal or external clients.

- **Business Requirements & Solution Definition**
 - Work with sponsors and key stakeholders for the elicitation and analysis of business, functional and non-functional requirements.
 - In collaboration with architects, suppliers and other the IT team members, construct a solution design to meet the business requirements
 - Ensuring the requirements are representative and the requirements & design are fully approved.
 - Ensuring that deliverables are fit for purpose and fully meet business requirements.
- **Project planning, control and governance:**
 - Ensuring a fit for purpose governance is applied and adhered to in terms of the project lifecycle, software development lifecycle and reporting.
 - The project plan is constructed from the project subject matter experts, approved and tracked.
 - The budget is approved and maintained
 - Updates and progress are communicated to the project teams
 - Escalations and approvals are made when project exceptions are highlighted that might impact the project plan, budget and scope
 - Maintaining a full audit trail of project decisions and the change control register
- **Team Management:**
 - Matrix management of a multi-disciplinary project teams.
 - Providing management in a supportive environment for the team with clear understanding of roles, responsibilities, timescales, deliverables and quality criteria.
 - Fostering a positive, consultative and collaborative team culture.
 - Ensuring regular and productive team communication.
- **Change management & Communications:**
 - Managing change in a structured and controlled manner to ensure the business benefits are realized.
 - Building key relationships with project stakeholders of all level of seniority – these could be both internal and external clients.
 - Extensive stakeholder engagement and communication using both formal and informal channels.
 - Listening, ensuring concerns are understood and feedback is delivered
 - Good news is promoted, and resistance addressed to ensure successful adoption.
 - The business and external users are fully prepared for the new system and ways of working.
- **Risk & Issue Management:**
 - Collaborating with the project team and business to highlight and analyse key project risks and issues.
 - Escalating and / or reporting on priority items as required

- Ensuring action is taken to approve and deliver mitigating corrective measures
- **Supplier Selection & Management:**
 - Ensuring the right suppliers are selected for the initiative – existing or new.
 - Building positive and effective relationships with the necessary suppliers
 - Ensuring their responsibilities, deliverables and timescales are agreed and understood
 - Ensuring legal have been engaged and are satisfied with the contracts in place
 - The supplier progress is measured and tracked on a time and material basis and/or fixed price engagement.
- **Other:**
 - Working in a hands-on capacity you will be willing to assist with other workstreams to maintain progress and to ensure the job gets done, such as workshop facilitation, solution selection, business analysis, testing and training.

- Extensive full lifecycle experience of delivering technology / digital change – mainly in the application, online or data space
- Experienced at performing the Business Analysis function in capturing and presenting requirements using user stories using other formal methods
